- (removed) Bollard collar in middle of trail
UPDATE (2/1/2012) This bollard and collar have been removed. There is a bollard collar here (used to be a bollard, too) for no reason. There is no intersection or street here. This needs to be removed.
- (removed) Bollard and collar at difficult spot
[05/12 - collar removed and surface smoothed] The collar here usually does not have the bollard in it. There is unlikely any vehicle encroachment here due to the fence, so the best solution would be to remove the collar.
- Dangerous collar (removed)
[update Aug 2012 - Collar removed and surface smoothed] The collar here sticks up. This side street is unlikely to experience any vehicle encroachment, so the best solution would be to remove the collar.
- Needless bollard here (formerly No bollard here)
5-16-12 A bollard has now been installed here despite the fact that there is no reason for it. It should be removed. (former description) There is no bollard or collar here and has not been for years.
- Worthless bollard
Due to the configuration of the intersection and the entrance to the trail, it seems unlikely that any cars would ever encroach on this section of trail. Recommend removing bollard and collar.
- Bollard collar no bollard
Often, there is a bollard collar here without a bollard. When it is c... it's very hard to see the collar, endangering cyclists and pedestrians.
- Harrison Street unnecessary bollard
[update 5/2012] The bollard is gone, but the collar remains. (prp note) This bollard should be removed, because it serves no purpose. It is at the intersection of the trail connector and the sidewalk.
- Unnecessary bollard
The bollard here is at the intersection of the sidewalk and the trail.
